What to bring for Day Camp:

All Campers: Please label all backpacks, carry-bags, towels, etc.

- Clothing: A change of clothing suitable for a day at camp, modest one-piece swimsuit, sweatshirt or jacket, extra pair of shoes. We do have water games some days, so dry clothes are recommended.
- Personal items: Towel, insect repellent, sunscreen, camera, etc.
- Study items: Bible, notebook, pen or pencil.
- Spending money: All campers will deposit their money in the camp bank when they
 register. Camp staff will keep a running total of their balance. Money left over at the end
 of the week will be refunded to your child on the last day of camp.

What to bring for Overnight Camp:

All Campers: Please label all luggage and belongings

- Clothing: Casual camp clothes, clothes for Friday night banquet, modest one-piece swimsuit, sweatshirt or jacket, extra pair of shoes
- Bedding: Pillow and sleeping bag or sheets and blankets
- Personal items: Towels, washcloth, soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste, flashlight, insect repellent, sun screen, camera, etc.
- Study items: Bible, notebook and a pen or pencil
- Spending money: All campers (with the exception of senior high campers) will deposit their money in the camp bank either when they register or when they check in for their session.
 Camp staff will keep a running total of their balance. Money left over at the end of the week will be refunded to your child on the last day of camp.

What to bring for Wilderness and Traverse Wilderness Camps

All Campers: Please label all luggage and belongings

- Clothing: Casual camp clothes, modest one-piece swimsuit, sweatshirt or jacket, extra pair of shoes
- Bedding: pillow, sleeping bag or sheets and blankets
- Personal items: Towel, sleeping bag or blankets, toiletries, insect repellent, sunscreen, camera, etc.
- Study items: Bible, notebook and a pen or pencil
- Spending money: All campers (with the exception of senior high campers) will deposit their
 money in the camp bank either when they register or when they check in for their session.
 Camp staff will keep a running total of their balance. Money left over at the end of the

- In addition to the list above, Wilderness campers should also bring the following: a school backpack to carry shower supplies, one or two plastic grocery bags, one or two pairs of old sneakers, one or two sets of clothes that can get dirty
